Last week my friend Alan Ould spent some time with one of the Chrysler engine experts, and discovered that Chrysler are building Formula 5,000 racing engines developing 490 b.h.p., which is more than the opposition can muster at the moment.

Naturally, I would like to obtain one of these engines as they are fully developed and sorted out to give optimum reliability and performance. The Chrysler engineer mentioned that he would like to see one of these engines racing in Australia, and that he would speak to you on his return to Detroit.

I am therefore writing to you, to enquire as to whether Chrysler Corporation would be interested in supplying an engine to us, or if not, whether Chrysler Australia would assist me in obtaining it and if I can obtain it, how much it would cost me.

Alan Ould will be returning to Australia on June the 12th so I will know more about his inquiries around that time.

One of the companies who make television films for Australian distribution has shown an interest in making a colour motor racing film around our car, as they are aware that there is a big market for good motor racing films overseas. The opportunities for promoting this car/engine combination are endless, so I hope that Chrysler can assist us.

If this engine is unavailable to me, I would still appreciate the 340 c.i. engine parts as previously requested.
